Mark C. Miller, LUTCF, UCL FINANCIAL GROUP

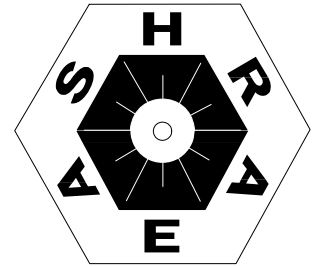
HIS TOPIC WILL BE:
