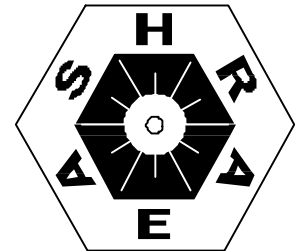
**H. Chris Moon**
