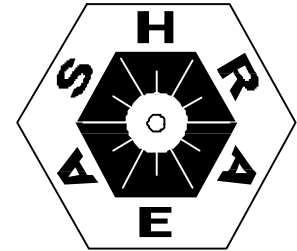

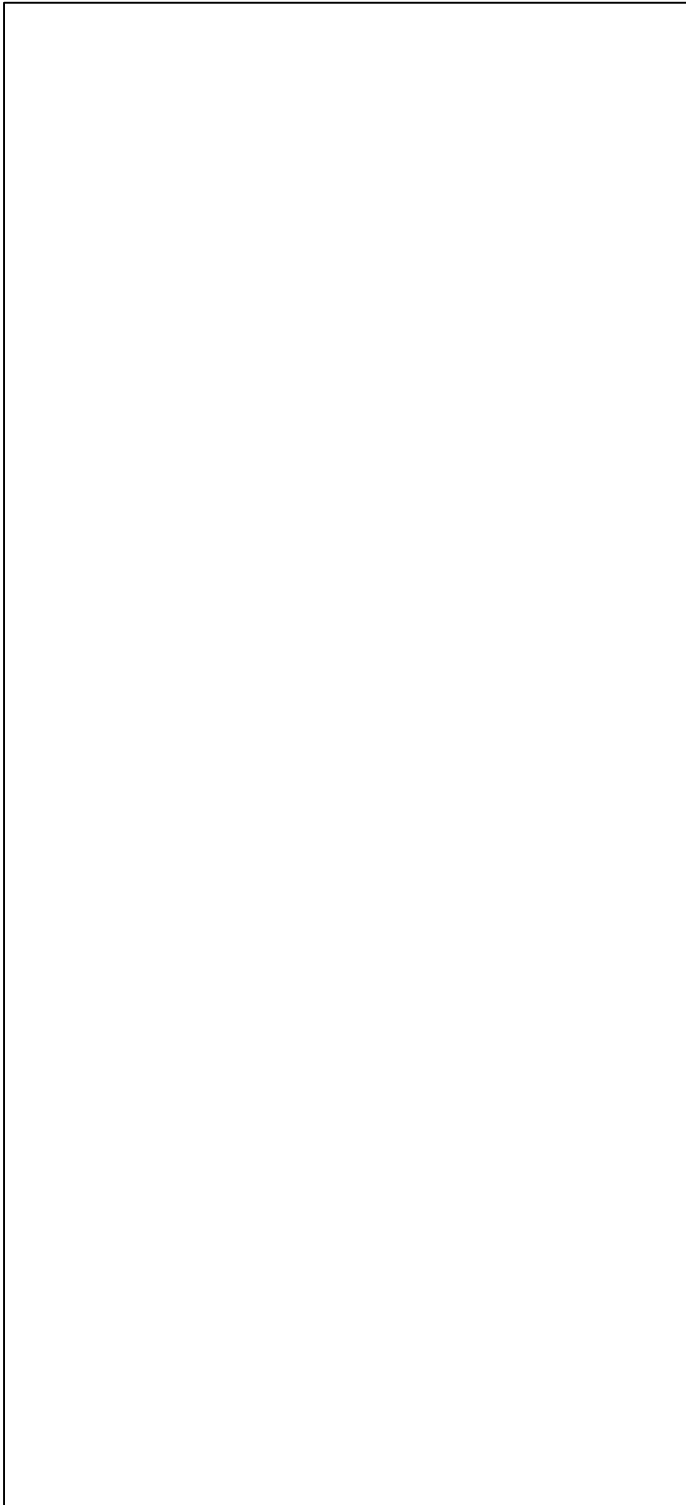

GORHAM/SCHAFFLER, INC.

Gorham/Schaffler, Inc. began on August 1, 1971 when Charlie Schaffler and Cliff Gorham purchased Brown Engineering and Equipment Company from C.L Brown, Jr. Among the original manufacturers represented by the company were Greenheck Fan and Ventilator Corporation and Baltimore Aircoil Company, which are still represented by Gorham/Schaffler today. In addition to Cliff and Charlie, the Company employed a receptionist/bookkeeper. Its offices were originally located at 2600 Poplar Ave., but were re-located to Nonconnah Corporate Center in 1972. The building at 3095 Stonebrook Circle, which the Company still occupies, was purchased in 1979.

Gorham/Schaffler experienced rapid and consistent growth and opened a Parts and Service department in 1976. GS Automation was formed in 1992 as the Company entered the Temperature Controls and Building Automation Systems business. A significant milestone occurred in 1989 when Gary Gorham graduated from UT Knoxville and became the first second generation family member to join the Company. Brian Schaffler came to Gorham/Schaffler in 1996 by way of CBU and the consulting engineering community of Denver, CO. Gary and Brian are currently majority shareholders with Gary serving as President and Brian as Vice President and Treasurer. Cliff Gorham retired from the Company in 2002.

Gorham/Schaffler, Inc. and GS Automation, Inc. employed twenty-four people as of January 1, 2006, including eight graduate engineers, two of whom are licensed Professional Engineers. The Company has provided equipment and/or controls on virtually every significant construction project in the area. The Company provides solutions to the most challenging applications, including laboratory fume hood control, the control and treatment of makeup air, natatorium design and specializes in the integration of equipment and systems into its Building Automation Systems. The Company is proud to represent manufacturers who are innovators in their fields and looks forward to continued growth and prosperity under the leadership of the second generation of the Gorham and Schaffler families.

3: Turn RIGHT (West) onto Park Ave	1.3 miles
4: Turn LEFT (South) onto Pendleton St	1.9 miles
5: Turn LEFT (East) onto Ketchum Rd	0.1 miles
6: Turn RIGHT (South) onto Scaper St, then immediately turn LEFT (East) onto Tarbora Ave	0.1 miles
7: Turn RIGHT (South) onto Scaper St	0.0 miles
8: Arrive	0.0 miles
