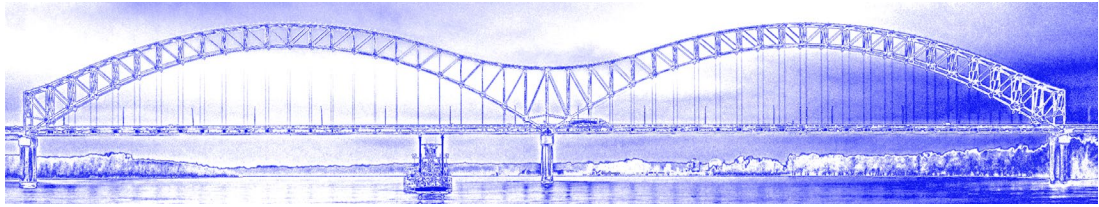




Memphis Chapter Memorial Resolutions
