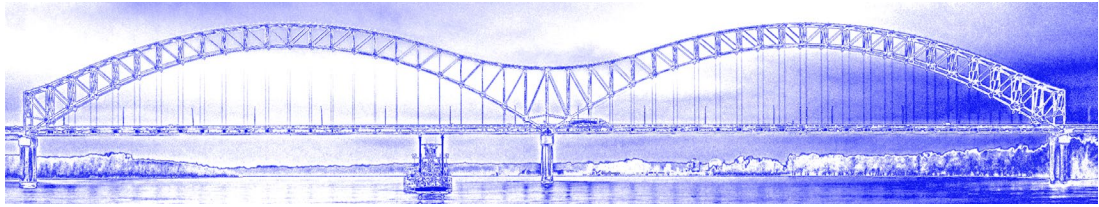




# *Memphis Chapter Memorial Resolutions*
